Yalgorup National Park: Beach Access Management Plan – Invitation to attend 2nd Stakeholder Workshop

In May 2021, the City of Mandurah hosted a Beach Access Management Planning (BAMP) workshop as part of its partnership with the Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions (DBCA) to enhance conservation outcomes and to promote sustainable visitation in and adjacent to Yalgorup National Park.

The purpose of the Beach Access Management Plan is to better align local government and DBCA land management actions to improve conservation, recreation and safety outcomes on beaches that adjoin the national park, as a key recommended action of the 2020 Yalgorup National Park Recreational Master Plan.

Much has taken place since the first workshop was held in 2021, and the City is pleased to invite you to the second BAMP workshop to provide an update on progress and to seek your further input into development of the plan.

With funding support from the Western Australian Government, the City and DBCA are currently partnering to develop a concept plan and detailed design for Yalgorup National Park that will incorporate beach access options for the Tims Thicket and White Hills areas adjacent to the park. Your feedback is sought to help further inform beach access options planning.

Following the second BAMP workshop, the Yalgorup National Park concept plan will be completed. This will be followed by the detailed design stage, which is anticipated to be completed later this year. Following this, the Beach Access Management Plan policy and procedures will be developed and implemented for Tims Thicket and White Hills, and additional government funding support will be sought for project development.

The workshop will be held at the **Mandurah Offshore Fishing and Sailing Club – 115 Breakwater Parade, Mandurah - on Thursday 8 June**, commencing at 9.30am.
