

# Clean Up Month 2024

Friends of the Rivers, Mandurah Environment & Heritage Group and Peel-Harvey Catchment Council are calling on our community this March to help us clean up our local reserves, beaches and waterways.

Step up to clean-up at community events across the Peel-Harvey Catchment to help prevent harm to our wildlife and keep our waterways clean.

The Peel-Harvey Catchment is home to the Peel-Yargorup wetlands encompassing our estuary and surrounding lakes. These wetlands hold international recognition as they are deemed crucial under the Ramsar Convention on Wetlands – Ramsar Site 482.

The entry of litter and debris into our waterways poses a threat to wildlife, leading to potential injuries and even death through entanglement

and ingestion of harmful substances like plastic. These waterways serve as habitats for a diverse range of species, from the Indo-Pacific Bottlenose Dolphins residing in our estuary to thousands migratory shorebirds.

This annual Clean Up Month unites various community groups and individuals in cleaning up our local reserves, beaches and waterways. This collective effort aims to benefit the many

species dependent on these waterways.
